A bible believing church

If you want to speak to someone about what you hear today, our minister, Phil LoBao, will usually be available near the main door.

Bible readings

We read from the New King James version. Bibles are available at the door. The page number for the church bibles will be announced to help you find the reading.



On-screen information

During the sermon there will usually be some notes projected on the wall to help you follow what's being said.



Singing

We use Christian Hymns and also project some songs on the wall. The song numbers are displayed in the front right-hand corner.



Kids Time (morning service)

We have a short time as part of the morning service aimed primarily at primary age children.



Children of pre-school age (morning service)

We have a creche room. A church member will be on hand when required during the sermon to look after your child. Prior to the sermon we would respectfully ask that you remain with your child if they are using the creche room, thank you. You can listen to the sermon via a speaker.

NB: During the evening service the creche room is still open for your use but there will not be a church member on duty.



Toy Bags: are available on your left as you enter the main hall. Please feel free to use them.



Children of primary school age (morning service)

We offer a Sunday Club class to cover this age range. This runs during the sermon.



Children of secondary school age (morning service)

To help young people to follow the sermon, worksheets with questions are produced every week. If you would like one, please ask one of the stewards on the door.



Welcome time ... we invite you to stay on after the service to get to know us. After the morning service we have tea and coffee, and usually biscuits!

There is no money offering taken during the service. No money is ever asked for or expected. Should you feel you want to donate to the work of the church, there is an offering box at the back of the hall.
